Work Begins in 2007 on LL Transportation Center

Work should begin this month on the village's new Intermodal Transportation Center following the award of the construction job to Longhorn Construction of Albuquerque.

Longhorn Construction was the lowest bidder at \$3,963,000. The village council approved the awarding of the job at a December meeting.

The center will be located adjacent to the stop for the New Mexico Rail Runner which began running from Los Lunas north in mid-December. The site is at the intersection of Juan Perea and Courthouse Roads just off Highway 314.

The transportation center will be home to the village Technology and Transportation departments. The Transportation Department will be providing rides to the Rail Runner station so having its office in the building and the vehicles headquartered at the facility will make coordinating the service easier.

Routes for the Rail Runner ride are being worked out by Transportation Department staff.


The center will also have an auditorium which will hold about 115 people and includes a balcony. The village council room is booked continuously and this will offer another venue for people to hold meetings and events.

Also in the center will be space for retail stores. Village officials hope that businesses which could be frequented by Rail Runner passengers and others will want to rent the space once the facility is built in seven to eight months.

Construction of the transportation center will provide added security for the Rail Runner station area as more people will be in the area during the day.

Village Administrator Phillip Jaramillo pointed out that cameras will also be placed throughout the parking lot and in the station area. The cameras will provide even more security.

As part of the job, Longhorn Construction will pave the second phase of the parking lot east of the station and transportation center.

Council Passes Open Meetings Resolution

The Los Lunas Village Council passed its annual Open Meetings Resolution at its December 28, 2006 meeting.

The resolution states that all meetings of the council will be "open to the public at all times," will be held only after reasonable notice to the public; and will be held at the Village Council Chambers at 660 Main Street.

The resolution also says special meetings may be called by the mayor or a majority of the council members upon three days notice or an emergency meeting will be called only under the unforeseen circumstances that demand immediate action to protect the health, safety and property of citizens to protect the public body from substantial financial loss.

The Los Lunas Village Council meets twice a month in the council chambers in the Administration Building on the corner of Don Pasqual and Main Street.
