LL Courtroom Named in Honor of Former Judge Richard Luna

The courtroom in the village's administration building has been named the Richard Luna Courtroom in honor of Luna who served more than 30 years as municipal judge in Los Lunas.

Richard Luna retired as judge in 2002 after serving those years consecutively following his first election to the position in 1968.

Luna also served as village marshal beginning in 1960, a time when the village had less than one thousand residents.

The Los Lunas Village Council approved a resolution naming the courtroom in Luna's honor at a January meeting which was held in the courtroom because the village council chambers were undergoing renovations.

Richard Luna and his family attended the meeting. He expressed his pleasure at the honor as did his family.

Absentee ballot applications for the March 4 election have been available at the office of the municipal clerk at the Administration Building, located at Don Pasqual and Main Street.

Applications for absentee ballots must be completed and accepted prior to 5 PM February 29.

Absentee voting by machine is being conducted at the Administration Building through 5 PM February 29.

Completed absentee ballots will be accepted until 7 PM March 4.

Maps of Districts One and Three which were created after the 2000 Census are located on page 3. Only people who live within these areas will vote in the 2008 election.




Museum of Heritage and Arts Opens In March

The village's Museum of Heritage and Arts will be open beginning in March at the corner of Luna Avenue and Main Street in the Augustin Archuleta Building.

The Museum of Heritage and Arts is part of an ongoing effort by the village council and staff to preserve the history of Los Lunas and the surrounding area.

The Archuleta Building underwent a \$384,451 renovation this summer which included gutting the building and reconstructing it as well as adding porches on the side and front and installing new windows. TEF Construction of Albuquerque performed the work.

The Archuleta Building most recently housed the village's technology department and in the past housed the village library, police department, the Chamber of Commerce and even Comcast Cable.

The museum will be part of the village's library system. Overseeing the museum will be former county manager James Fernandez.

Watch for information in the newspaper and other places about the opening of the museum and special presentations.

The museum is expected to be open afternoons Tuesday through Saturday. Call the museum at 352-7720 for information about when it is open and the exhibits slated for the facility.
