A license is required for "all persons, firms, corporations or associations of any character engaged in any of the various pursuits, businesses or occupations" in the village before March 15 every year at the latest.

In the event that any license fee is not paid by the fifteenth day of March, a penalty in the amount of ten percent of the license fee due shall be added for late filing, according to the village ordinance.

Licenses are renewed annually. Village staff send out notices in the latter part of the year to make it easier to renew.

Museum Has New Exhibit

"Through the Eyes of the Cowboy" is the new exhibit at the Village's Museum of Heritage and Arts, located the intersection of Main Street and Luna Avenue, which is under the water tower.

The exhibit features western artist Bob Lee and the history of cattle and sheep ranching in the greater Los Lunas area.

The exhibit runs until March 31.

The museum is open from noon to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays. It is closed Sunday and Monday.

Admission is free to the museum.

The museum's last exhibit of 2008 was Saints and Sacred Places which featured the history of area churches and the artwork of Rio Abajo Santeros.

Council Passes Open Meetings Resolution

The Los Lunas Village Council passed its annual Open Meetings Resolution at its December 4, 2008 meeting.

The resolution states that all meetings of the council will be "open to the public at all times;" will be held only after reasonable notice to the public; and will be held at the Village Council Chambers at 660 Main Street in the administration building.

The resolution also says special meetings may be called by the mayor or a majority of the council members upon three days notice or an emergency meeting will be called only under the unforeseen circumstances that demand immediate action to protect the health, safety and property of citizens or to protect the public body from substantial financial loss.
