

New Police Chief on Job in Los Lunas

The new police chief for the Village of Los Lunas has nearly 30 years of experience in investigative and police work.

Roy E. Melnick takes over the job of police chief in mid-March. He is replacing Police Chief Nick Balido who retired after more than three decades with the department.

Melnick comes to Los Lunas from St. Johns, Arizona, where he served as chief of police since April 2008. Prior to his tenure in St. Johns, Melnick was Chief of Police in Ashland, Massachusetts, for six years and also served as captain and assistant chief in Londonderry, New Hampshire, for twelve years.

Melnick has a law degree from the Massachusetts School of Law and a master's degree of business administration from Rivier College

as well as a bachelor of science with a concentration in criminal justice from St. Anselm's College.

He is or has been a member of several professional organizations including the Arizona chapter of the FBI National Academy and the International Chiefs of Police Association.

Melnick and his wife Melissa have six children.

Work Begins This Spring On Carson/Main Street Intersection

Work begins this Spring on a \$381,428 project which will improve the intersection of Main Street, also known as New Mexico Highway 6, and Carson Drive.

Contracting and Management Inc. of Albuquerque was awarded the contract for the job by the Los Lunas Village Council.

The work will be conducted primarily on Carson Drive so that traffic problems on Main Street will be minimal.

Among the improvements are creating additional parking for the United States Post Office on the southeast corner of the intersection, closing the north exit for the post office, making what is now the south entrance for the post office into a combined exit/entrance, and aligning that exit/entrance for the post office with the bank's exit.

The work is expected to take about five months so it should be completed sometime in Fall, 2009.

Project Updates

The Village's \$4.2 million Interceptor Sewer Improvement Project is about 90 percent complete.

Village Public Utilities Director Betty Behrend said the main portion of the project is finished.

This project includes extending an 18-inch sewer line along Morris Road to serve the new Valencia County Courthouse and then proceeding across Highway 314 to the wastewater treatment plant.

Work will begin on changes to the intersection of Los Lentos and Main Street, (also known as Highway 6) once the final traffic control plan has been approved.

Several paving projects will go to bid this Spring with work to begin in the Summer.

Have You Renewed Your Business License?

It's time to renew your business license. All businesses, local or national, pay the same fee, \$25.

A license is required for "all persons, firms, corporations or associations of any character engaged in any of the various pursuits, businesses or occupations" in the village before March 15 every year at the latest.

In the event that any license fee is not paid by the fifteenth day of March, a penalty in the amount of ten percent of the license fee due shall be added for late filing, according to the village ordinance.

Licenses are renewed annually.
