Coronavirus Safety Tips

Los Lunas, NM- Following recommendations from the Office of the Governor of New Mexico, in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus), the need for our community to comply with the stay-at-home order and to practice social distancing when absolutely necessary to leave your home, is more vital than ever. We must work together to limit community spread.

As a reminder, the NMDOT discourages shopping in groups. The department also advises New Mexicans follow COVID-19 precautions while shopping.

- **Practice social distancing. Stay at least 6 feet away from those around you.**
- **Cover your coughs and sneezes with your elbow or tissue.**
- **If possible, wipe down your shopping cart and wash your hands for at least 20 seconds before and after unloading your groceries.**
- **No public gatherings over 5 people**

The Village of Los Lunas is monitoring the situation closely while working in partnership with our local, state and federal partners to ensure the safety of our community and employees. We want to thank you our community for their understanding and cooperation as we all do our part to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
