### **Los Lunas Public Library Purchases eBook Platforms with GO Bond Funds**

**Los Lunas, NM** – The Los Lunas Public Library recently purchased two eBook platforms in an effort to provide access to reading materials for the youth and teens of the area.

While patrons can download eBooks and eAudiobooks at *New Mexico Library to Go*: <https://nm.overdrive.com/> the selection for youth and teens is very limited. To address this limitation, the Los Lunas Public Library purchased access to *Tumble Book Library* and *Teen Book Cloud* utilizing New Mexico General Obligation Bond funds.

**Tumble Book Library** is an online database of over 1,100 titles for grades K – 6, and includes unique animated, talking picture books, Graphic Novels, read-along chapter books, National Geographic videos, non-fiction books, playlists, as well as books in Spanish and French. **Teen Book Cloud** is an online database of eBooks and educator resources perfect for middle school and high school students. The database offers a robust selection of Graphic Novels, Enhanced Novels, eBooks, classic literature, National Geographic videos, educator resources, and audiobooks. General Obligation Bond funds are voted upon by New Mexico voters every two years to help support public, school, academic, and tribal libraries in the state in providing services to the public. The next GO Bond is on the November 3, 2020 ballot as GO Bond Issue B in the amount of \$9,500,000. The GO Bond Issue will provide \$3,000,000 each for Academic libraries, Public libraries, and Public School libraries as well as \$500,000 for NM Tribal libraries. It is estimated that Valencia County academic, public, and school libraries stand to gain close to \$240,000 dollars if the bond issue passes.

The Los Lunas Public Library is proud it is utilizing these taxpayer approved funds to help provide services to youth and teens during this COVID-19 pandemic.
