

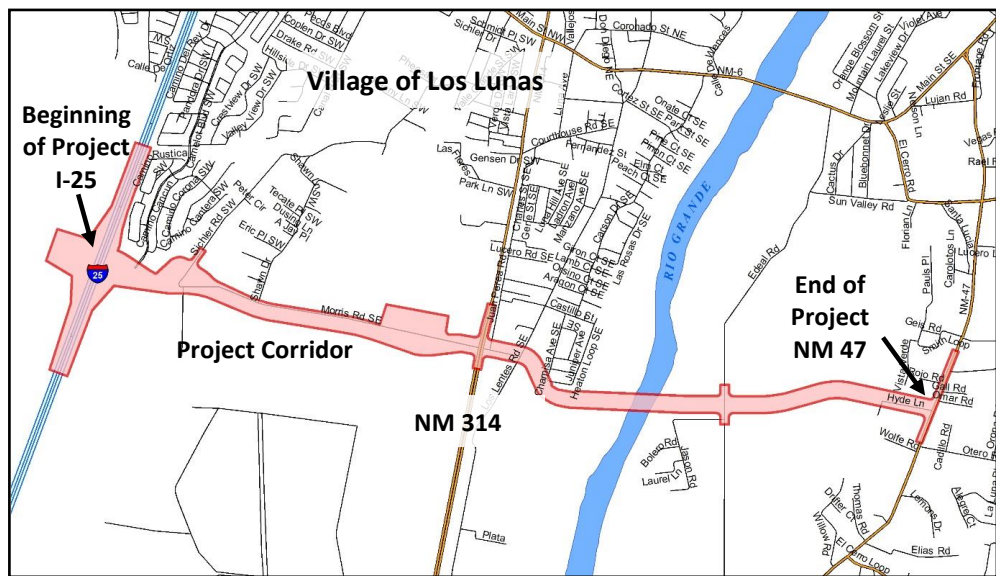


REQUEST FOR PUBLIC INPUT

Los Lunas I-25 Interchange and East-West Corridor

The Village of Los Lunas, in cooperation with the New Mexico Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration, are hosting a Virtual Public Meeting to provide information and obtain your valuable input on the Los Lunas Interstate 25 (I-25) Interchange and East-West Corridor. The project would extend from I-25 east across the Rio Grande to NM 47 in Los Lunas and Valencia County, New Mexico. The purpose of the project is to improve traffic flow on NM 6 and other facilities, provide access to high growth areas, and enhance the efficiency of emergency response services. Proposed improvements would include a new I-25 interchange approximately 1.6 miles south of the I-25/NM 6 Interchange. The project would extend east of I-25 just south of existing Morris Road to NM 314. From NM 314, the proposed corridor would continue east across the BNSF Railway tracks, Los Lentos Road, and the Rio Grande, terminating at NM 47. Ultimately, the project is anticipated to be a four-lane roadway with access limitations; however, the initial construction may consist of a two-lane road with phased construction.
