The exhibit contains stories of courage under fire, gallantry, service, and honor. There are artifacts from many families that have been donated or loaned to the museum for display. New this year, the VFW Post 9678 and Valencia Art Center will host their first annual Veterans Art Exhibit and Sale. This art show is open to all artists, both youth and adults, in Valencia County. The theme is "Welcome Home: A Patriotic Art Tribute to Our Nation's Veterans." Information packets and sign up forms are available at the museum, the last day for entries is October 17. Kauau Ruins - Coronado Historic Site Van Tour Saturday, November 22

Join us for a van trip to the Kauau Ruins (Coronado Historic Site) in Bernalillo, NM. The Kuaua Pueblo was the northernmost of the twelve villages visited by Vasquez de Coronado. The village was first settled around 1325

AD and had about 1200 inhabitants. We will do a outdoor 45 minute docent-led tour which includes going inside the Painted Kiva (accessed via a ladder). The path is approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile long. Paved walking paths and museum are ADA accessible. We'll have lunch in their ramadas that overlook the Rio Grande. Cost of tour

is \$5 per person. Please bring a sack lunch, water bottle, sunscreen, and hat. Call us at (505) 352-7720 to reserve your spot. Space is limited.



Historical Highlight



The Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railway Depot - Los Lunas

The railroad was built in 1879. The Los Lunas Depot was originally 118.5 feet long. The freight room was expanded in 1886 and then shortened by 30 feet in 1942. The depot is no longer in use as a railway station. It was moved in 1976 to where it currently sits on State Road 314. The Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 9676 uses it. It is notable as one of the oldest surviving depots in New Mexico.


