Vice President, John R Chavez, opened meeting at 12:00pm; Self-introductions.
 Review and approval March 23rd, 2016 minutes. Motion to approve minutes by Ragon Espinosa; 2nd by Stephen Chavez; All in favor. Approved.

Review and approval of agenda. Motion to approve agenda by Carol Claus; 2nd by Ragon Espinosa; All in favor. Approved.

New Business:

Presentation by TNT Boxing and Mentoring Club:

- Mario Tapia opened presentation with background on TNT Boxing and Mentoring Club and played video. Ms. Ginny reported that the club recently purchased property/land for club to use near the area of Tome. The club has plans for the new property that include:
 - Connecting the kids with the land in hopes of creating an appreciation for agriculture
 - Create community service programs for the kids to give back
 - Bring positive male and female role models into the kid's lives

Ms. Ginny also advocated for support from council meeting attendees to attend and show their support during an upcoming planning and zoning meeting to be held June 28th, 2016 at 3:00pm. The club will be required to receive approval to continue using land as a conditional use.

Media Contest/DWI Program Slide Show:

- Ms. Ginny reported;
 - Description of media contest and entries
 - Visa Cards were given as prizes primarily because they would be able to purchase everyday essentials if needed.
 - Ms. Ginny and Mr. Stephen Chavez read two 2 poem entries that placed.
 - The Movies after Prom event was a success and provided a safe after Prom option for students.

On-Going Business:

YDI/Teen Court/Alcohol Density Youth Coalition Update – Mr. Cruz Munoz reported:

- Teen Court is fundraising to send 4 high school participants to The Law Institute in Washington for weeklong training.
- There have been 60+ referrals from JPPO with all closed, but 1 case.
- Teen court is working LLHS to train 20 students to be teen attorneys.
- Teen court is seeing a lot of success.

Ms. Stephen Chavez reported that The Youth Coalition at School of Dreams Academy (SODA) has been working on a mentor program. They are trying to work towards getting other schools involved to mentor the younger students.

Drug Court – Mr. Ragon Espinoza reported:

- Working with hardest group of drug court participants to date.
- Judge Tina R. Garcia and Miles attended National Drug court conference in Anaheim, California and reported to the group.

District Attorney's Office – Mr. Andrew Magida reported:

- Continued work on gathering detailed facts/statistics, all information gathered will need to be reviewed and approved by new Deputy D.A. Robert Blanch before released.
- New Deputy D.A Robert Blanch who will be filling Ron Lopez' soon to be vacant position. Mr. Blanch confirmed that he would follow up with Mr. Ron Lopez in regards to reporting numbers back to council next meeting.

Valencia Shelter Services (VSS) – Ms. Alexandria Taylor reported:

- Focusing on money received to hire new sexual violence coordinator.
- Entering two year program focused on teen pregnancy and prevention.
- Expanding treatment services in community and accepting more referrals.

Prevention/Enforcement – Ms. Ginny Adame provided report during the business portion of the meeting.

- Enforcement:
 - 10 operations saturation patrols—statics provided
 - Decline in drinking and underage drinking parties
 - NMSP did 9 patrols—statistics provided

Ms. Ginny reminded council meeting that there is still a risk for transfer to NMHSD and the need for ongoing support from council/local leadership.

Compliance – Ms. Rachel Martinez reported:

- Quarterly Compliance meeting was held with the Judges, court staff, DAs office, Valencia Shelter Services and Compliance Staff. CM Program is working on gaining access to view only access to the Magistrate court data base Odyssey.

Alternative Sentencing/RMOMS – RMOMS staff was not present

- Ms. Ginny Adame provided a brief introduction of RMOMS for those who are present for meeting, but not familiar with the services they provide.

Treatment – Ms. Jennifer Sandoval reported:

- Treatment participant numbers have been average
 - 55 referrals
 - 41 DWI CM referrals
 - 1 Drug court
 - 11 other (pre-trial, CYFD, Sierra county, ABQ., San Miguel County, District)
 - 2 Self referrals
 - 2 graduated successfully
 - 5 unsuccessful

Open Discussion/Topics for Next Agenda:

- Bart Regelbrugge: FYI discussion on stress and how it can negatively or positively affect you depending upon mindset. Hand out provided.
- Stephen Chavez: Recommendation to watch TED Program video which can be found on YouTube on Stress.
